

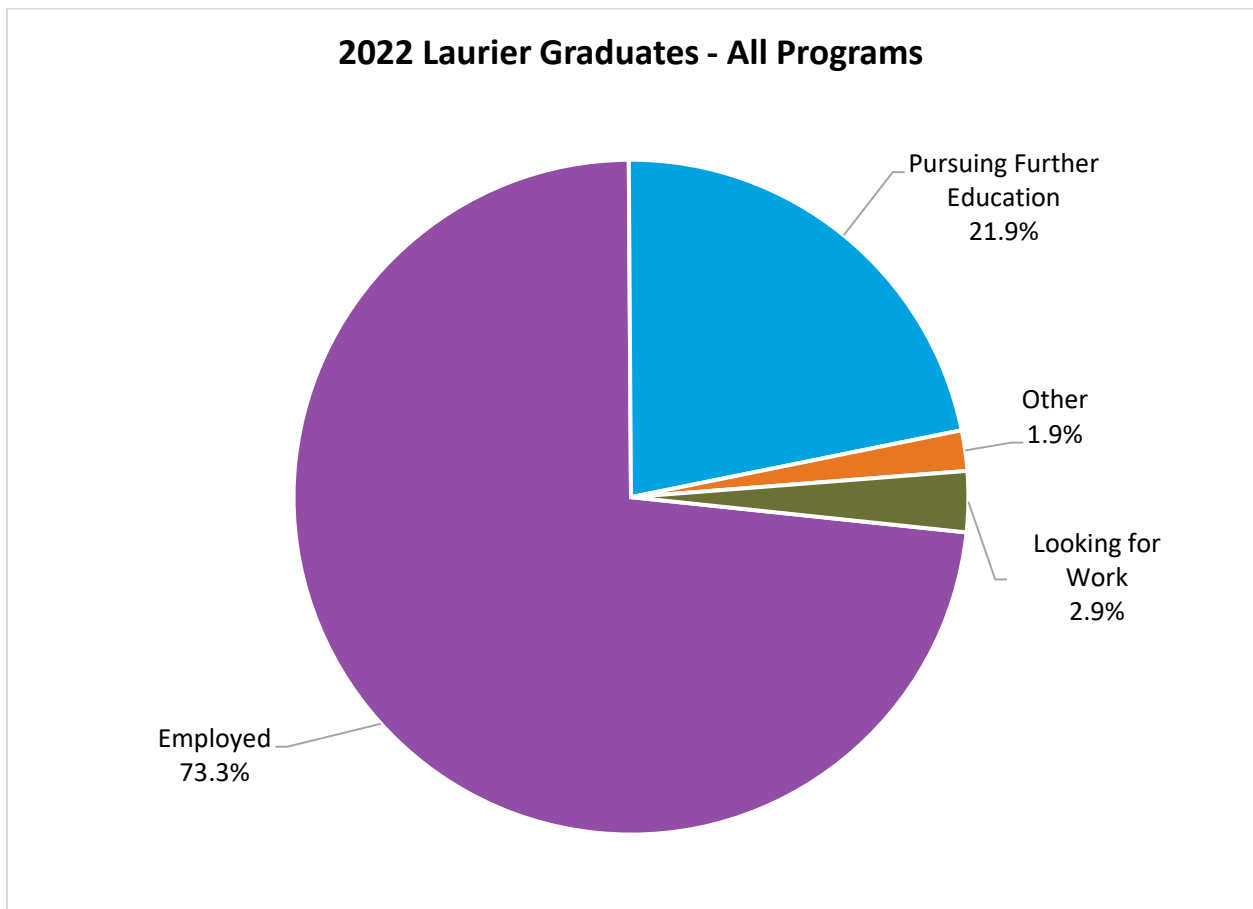
2022 Laurier Graduate Outcomes Survey Report

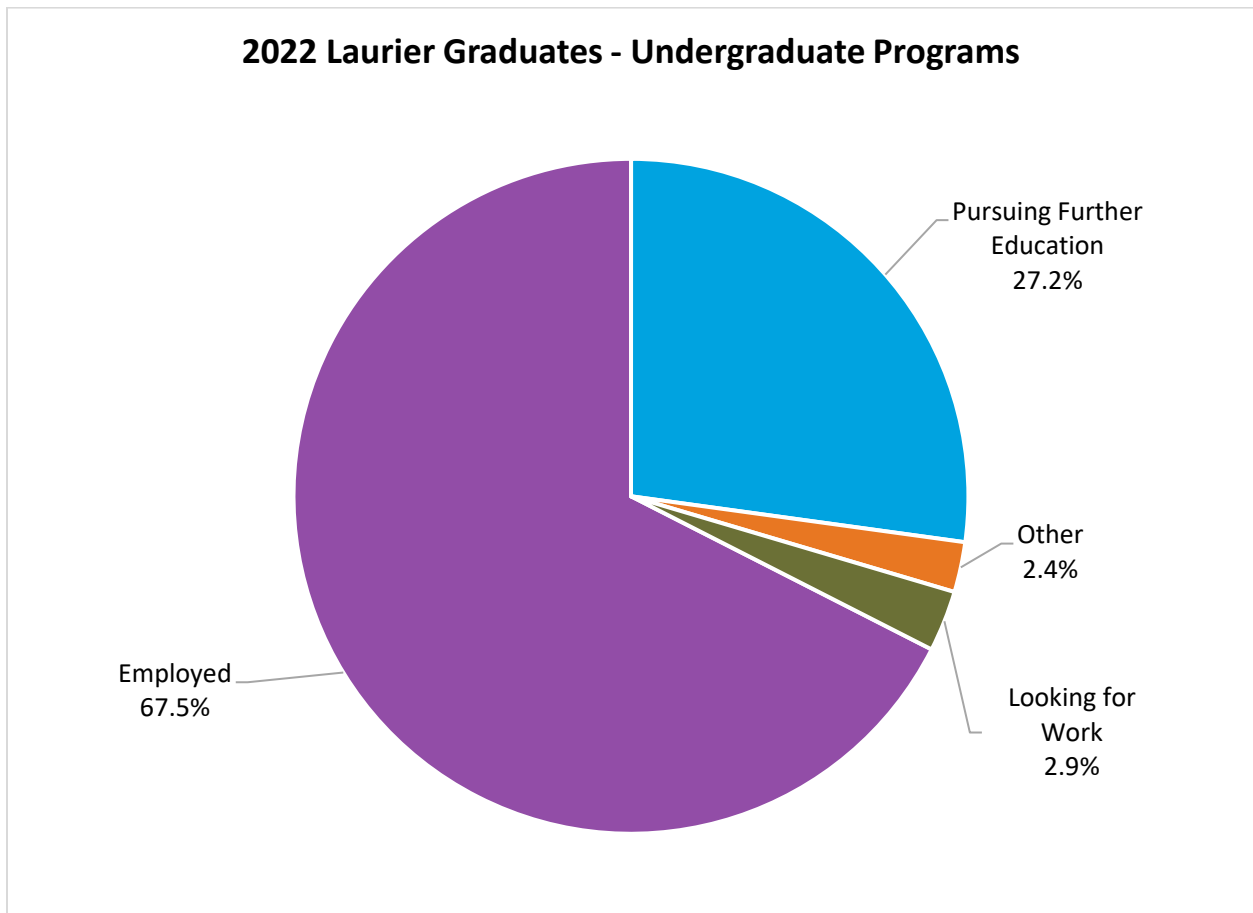
