

Transcript Key

Wilfrid Laurier University is a multi-campus, degree-granting institution and an accredited member of Universities Canada. The language of instruction is English, with the exception of language courses taught in the target languages offered. Laurier was established as the Evangelical Lutheran Seminary of Canada in 1911 and later changed its name to Wilfrid Laurier University in 1973. Martin Luther University College remains a federated college of Laurier.

Course Number:	
A first digit of 1, 2, 3 or 4 normally corresponds to the year level in an undergraduate program. A first digit of 5 or above represents a course at the graduate level.	
Course Weight:	
The weighting factor is used to count course credits and calculate averages. For undergraduate courses, a weight of 0.5 approximates a 12-week (one-term) course of three contact hours per week. For graduate courses, a weight of 0.5 approximates a 13-week (one-term) course. Other weights are accordingly proportioned by duration and/or lecture hours.
