An Honours degree is 20.0 credits. Students must complete at least 10.0 credits of EN (each course is 0.5 credits), as follows:

Min. 1.0 credit 100-level EN:

Min. 0.5 credits EN theory (EN301 or EN240):

Min. 2.5 credits 300-level EN:

1.0 credit 400-level EN:

Min. 5.0 credits of 200- or 300-level EN courses (taken in any order following completion of 100-level):

Total: 10.0 credits of EN courses

Other requirements for Honours English degree:

- Students can count no more than 14.0 credits of EN towards their Honours degree
- EN GPA 5.0 (min.) to progress and 7.0 (min.) to graduate
- Overall GPA 5.0 (min.) to progress and graduate
- Students whose EN GPA falls between 5.0 and 7.0 at the end of Year 3 should contact the EN Undergraduate Advisor for advice about alternate options.
- **Optional:** max. 1.0 credit from 200-/300-level FS courses, EN206, or EN304 may be counted towards the min. 10.0 credits for Honours English

Requirements for all Honours degrees:

- 20.0 credits total (min.)
- No more than 6.0 credits can be counted at the 100-level

Further Recommendations:

Try to take a variety of courses in different fields / areas so that you can experience a wide range of what English Literary Study has to offer. EN245 (Brit. Lit. Tradition I) and EN246 (Brit. Lit. Tradition II) are recommended as good background courses for EN Majors.
