

## **Honours BA in Philosophy**

ProgramOutline – applicable from July 1, 2019

## The Honours Philosophy program consists of 20.0 credits.

- 1. No more than 6.0 credits may be at the 100 level.
- 2. The program must include at least 11.0 but no more than 13.0 credits in Philosophy.
- 3. A minimum GPA of 5.0 overall and a 7.0 in Philosophy is required to graduate.
- 4. Prerequisites for 4<sup>th</sup> year seminars are any two of PP350, PP370 and PP380.
- 5. The program must include 3.5 credits in Philosophy at the 300 and 400 level, with at least 1.5 credits at each of those levels
