

Graduation Requirements for Honours Sociology in Combination with Another Major

Checklist for Students

The combined Honours BA Sociology program consists of 20.0 credits, of which at least 13.0 must be at the senior level (i.e., 200-level and above). A minimum of 7.0 credits in Sociology must be completed including SY101, SY103, SY207, SY210 or SY213, SY280, SY281, SY382, SY389.

1.0 additional SY credits at the 300 level and 0.5 SY credits at the 400 level.

The following checklist is based on the minimum required 7.0 credits in Sociology.

¹Either SY101 or SY103 can be used as a prerequisite for second year required courses in Sociology. We encourage students to complete both courses by the end of first year (or as soon as possible after that). You must complete both SY101 and SY103 to graduate.

²SY489 and SY490 do not count in this 0.5 credit maximum.

Reminder:

- **DO NOT TAKE MORE THAN 7.0 credits at the 100 level.**
- To progress in honours you need a GPA (average) of 4 (C-) or more in your Sociology courses and a GPA of 4 or more overall (all courses combined).
- For program progression to 4th year standing, you need a GPA of 5 (C) or more in your Sociology courses.
- To graduate with honours, you need a GPA of 7 (B-) or more in Sociology and 5 (C) or more overall.
- To graduate with honours, you require 20.0 credits in total (major and electives together).
- If you're doing a double major, consult with an advisor about equivalent courses for SY280 and SY382.
