

Graduation Requirements for General BA in Sociology Checklist for Students

The General BA Sociology [program](#) consists of 15.0 credits, of which no more than 7.0 may be at the [junior](#) level (100 level). A minimum of 6.0 credits (5.0 [senior](#)) in Sociology must be completed, including 5.0 senior SY credits and the following:

[SY101](#), [SY103](#) (or SY102); [SY207](#) (or SY203*); [SY210](#) or [SY213](#); [SY280](#), [SY281](#); [SY389](#) (or SY387 or SY388).

The following checklist is based on the minimum required 6.0 credits in Sociology.

¹Either SY101 or SY103 can be used as a prerequisite for second year required courses in Sociology. We encourage students to complete both courses by the end of first year (or as soon as possible after that). You must complete both SY101 and SY103 to graduate.

Reminder:

- **DO NOT TAKE MORE THAN 7.0 credits at the 100 level.**
- To progress and graduate with the BA Sociology, you need a GPA (average) of 4 (C-) or more in your Sociology courses and a GPA of 4 or more overall (all courses combined).
- To graduate with BA General, you require 15 credits in total (major and electives together).
- A minimum of 6.0 senior credits must be taken at Wilfrid Laurier University.
