

LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

We would like to acknowledge that Wilfrid Laurier University and its campuses are located on the shared traditional territory of the Neutral, Anishnaabe (Anish-nah-bay) and Haudenosaunee (Hoe-den-no-show-nee) peoples.

This land is part of the Dish with One Spoon Treaty between the Haudenosaunee and Anishnaabe peoples and symbolizes the agreement to share, protect our resources and not to engage in conflict.

From the Haldimand Proclamation of Oct. 25, 1784, this territory is described as: "six miles deep from each side of the river (Grand River) beginning at Lake Erie and extending in the proportion to the Head of said river, which them and their posterity are to enjoy forever." the proclamation was signed by the British with their allies, the Six Nations, after the American Revolution.

Despite being the largest reserve demographically in Canada, those nations now reside on less than five percent of this original territory.

STUDYING AT OXFORD






- It is expected that Rhodes Scholars to study at Oxford for two years


A commitment to lead and engage with fellow beings, showcasing strong moral character.

WHAT DOES THE RHODES SCHOLARSHIP COVER?



- The Rhodes Scholarship covers Oxford
 University fees, as well as providing an annual stipend.
- Following selection for the Scholarship, the Rhodes Trust will cover the application fee required to **study** at the University of Oxford.
- The Trust will cover the fee for a Tier 4 study
 visa and the associated International Health
 Surcharge (IHS).
- Two economy class **flights** to and from the UK
 for the beginning and end of studies in
 Oxford.
- On arrival in Oxford, Scholars also receive a settling in allowance.





REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY

Citizenship

- Citizen, permanent resident, protected person of Canada.
- Live in Canada.

Age

 Ages 18-23 on 1st October 2025

OR

• Under the age of **27** on 1st October 2025

AND

completed your **first** undergraduate degree on or after 1 October 2024*.

Academic Achievement

- Completed an undergraduate degree (usually a Bachelor's) by July 2026.
- Academic background and grade that at a minimum
 meets or exceeds the specific entry requirements of your chosen course at the University of Oxford.
- Candidates will have a higher chance of successful admission to Oxford if they have 'A' or 83%.


Academic Statement

To be eligible to apply for the Rhodes Scholarship, you must receive official university endorsement from the institution.


You must complete Laurier's internal application to be considered for Laurier's endorsement of your application for the Rhodes Scholarship Program.

Cover page


- Name, address, phone number, e-mail address, faculty, program of study, year of study.
- **CV** (maximum 2 pages, 12 pt. font)
- Statement of Interest (maximum 1000 words)
 - Include your proposed course of study.
 - Who you are, what matters to you and what you hope to do in the world.

3 Academic References

 Faculty members with direct knowledge of your scholastic and other achievements.

3 Character References

 Direct knowledge of your volunteer and public service duties.



What's Next?

 Evaluation of all complete applicants.

Evaluation by the VPA's Office

- Shortlisted candidates are carefully reviewed by the VPA's office.
- Evaluation may involve interviews.

 The VPA's office recommends the top students for endorsement.

Review by the President's Office

Endorsement

 The President's Office endorses students for the Rhodes scholarship.



Laurier's Endorsement

If you are endorsed, you will receive support from our campus partners to ensure that your package is as strong as possible.

- Writing support from Teaching & Learning regarding your personal statement.
- Career and Co-op provide feedback to strengthen your resume.
- A faculty mentor will support the preparation of your package and provide feedback to your references.
